**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE GUNNISON COUNTY EARLY INTERVENTION FEES
POLICY**

WHEREAS, Gunnison County has established a uniform policy format and an adoption and periodic review process to promote consistency and uniformity throughout the organization; and

WHEREAS, the current *Gunnison/Hinsdale Juvenile Diversion Fees Policy*, adopted on January 9, 1990 via Resolution #1990-1 (Exhibit A), includes outdated and erroneous information; and

WHEREAS, the attached *Gunnison County Early Intervention Fees Policy* (Exhibit B) was created to reflect Gunnison County's current language and fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Gunnison County, Colorado that:

1. The attached Resolution #1990-1 and *Gunnison/Hinsdale Juvenile Diversion Fees Policy* (Exhibit A) are immediate rescinded; and
2. The attached *Gunnison County Early Intervention Fees Policy* (Exhibit B) is adopted;



WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Gunnison County, Colorado, has reviewed the Gunnison/Hinsdale Juvenile Diversion Fees Policy (a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein) and finds it to be reasonable and appropriate; and

GUNNISON/HINSDALE JUVENILE DIVERSION FEES POLICY

1. a. All Juvenile Diversion clients will be charged a fee.
 - b. The fee charged will be \$50.00 per client. The clients will be allowed to pay by making arrangements to pay a set amount per month. The fee will not be based on units of service.
The fee will be based on the ability to pay. At the Juvenile Diversion Specialist's discretion, all or a portion of this fee may be waived in lieu of additional community service hours to be compensated at the prevailing minimum wage rate.
 - c. The fee will go into the Juvenile Diversion budget to offset operating costs.
 - d. The consequences for failure to pay would be court action.
2. In order to report to DCJ quarterly, the Gunnison County Finance Department will document records of fees collected and the Juvenile Diversion office will send this accounting information into DCJ. These fees will also be reported in the Gunnison County annual audit and Gunnison County will forward a copy of this annual audit to DCJ.
3. The Gunnison County Commissioners will be asked to adopt a resolution for approval of this fee policy and upon approval of this request a copy of this approved resolution will be forwarded to the state DCJ office.

PURPOSE

Collection of these fees helps to offset the cost of the Early Intervention Activity.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all Gunnison County Early Intervention Activity clients.

DEFINITIONS

POLICY STATEMENTS

Fees:

All Juvenile Services clients will be charged a fee of \$100 per case.

1. Basis. Fees will be based on an individual client's ability to pay, which may result in lowered fees for any clients who are unable to pay the full fee. Fees will not be based on units of service.
2. Payment Terms. Fees may be paid via cash or check. Partial payments will be allowed, but payment in full must be received no later than four (4) months after fee assignment.
3. Waivers. At the Juvenile Services Director's discretion, all or a portion of a client's fee may be waived in lieu of additional community-service hours to be compensated at the rate of \$10/hour.
4. Deposits. Fees received will be deposited into the Gunnison County Juvenile Services Department's Early Intervention Activity budget.
5. Failure to Pay. A client's failure to pay their assessed fee or satisfy any alternate arrangements described in #2 above, may result in court action.

Reporting:

The Gunnison County Finance office will document records of fees collected, and the Juvenile Services Department will submit this accounting information to the Division of Criminal Justice on quarterly basis.

COMPLIANCE

This policy shall be complied with in all respects. Revisions to this policy may occur. However, when deemed necessary in order to fully protect the County's interests, the interest of the public, and to more fully protect the safety of the public, including employees governed by this policy, this policy may be changed without notice.
