

Minutes of the Public Hearing

January 6, 2000

Dave opened the public hearing, with three board members present. He then had the confirmation of adequate public notice, by showing the proof of publication, and had Ray announce he had posted it on the property.

Ray then presented the nomination of the Bomber Crash Site. He told how the aircraft had burned at the time of the crash, on July 19, 1943. The site is located up Taylor Canyon between Lodgepole and Cold Spring Campgrounds..

Next, were the questions and comments from the public. Larry Dolezal spoke of being all for this nomination. He said we should do it, and that it should be an 'honor to protect the history' of such events. We then asked for any opposition, or other comments.

The commission questions were: where the location of the crash site was in relationship to the road, and where all the fragments were found. Ray told that the location of most of the aircraft is on the South side of the road, and some tail fragments were found on the North side of the river.

The staff comments were: how nice the packet was put together, and the map and photos were great to add to this.

Dave closed the public hearing. He then had the board members vote on the sending this nomination on to the BOCC. It was unanimous to continue the process. Then Dave thanked Ray for a great presentation.

Kathy asked to go over a couple of items that need to be addressed prior to the next meeting. First, the schedule of meetings for this year. Everyone said 'same time, same place' was good for them. Kathy will contact the others for a response. Next, there was a memo requesting that we recommend a person(city resident) to be appointed to the board to also be a liaison between the City and the County HPC boards. That was voted unanimously to recommend the person applying for the alternate position. Finally, we discussed the other book about the Old Spanish Trail being held at the Bookworm, if we wish to purchase it. Ruth said she has the book, and would make it available to all of us when we need it.
