Justin opened the meeting and the group reviewed the minutes from the last meeting. Jody made a motion (2nd by Lynn) to approve the minutes. It was approved unanimously.

The group discussed the Marble Jailhouse nomination for the national register. Dave made a motion (2nd by Jody) to recommend approval of the nomination. It was approved unanimously. The group discussed the merits of adding the site to the local register. Justin said he would pursue this by contacting the nominator and that he would submit the paperwork to the state regarding the HPC's recommendation.

Justin said the historic survey project is completely finished and turned into the state.

Justin said there was no new information regarding the Mountaineer site and that he would send the HPC members the FCC document that was discussed.

Lyda said that she and Lee Ann attended the State Historical Fund Community Roundtable in Gunnison on July 14th. She said various local entities attended and discussed grant possibilities with the state. She provided Mike with a thumb drive of info from the state with the latest forms and guides. Lyda and Mike described the current status of the HPC collection of oral histories. All the tapes have been converted to digital format except for Duane Phelps (missing), Lawrence Phelps (no sound on tape), and Kincaid (Mike will try to retrieve this from the Library).

The group decided to move the next meeting to August 24th due to vacations. The group will discuss the budget at the next meeting.

Justin said there was some vandalism at the Alpine Tunnel and also that there is some progress towards fixing the damage to the rockwall near the Alpine Tunnel.

Jody said she will be discussing grant opportunities with the Gunnison Arts Center soon.
