Justin opened the meeting and the group reviewed the minutes from the last meeting. Jordan made a motion (2<sup>nd</sup> by Lee Ann) to approve the minutes. It was approved unanimously.

The group discussed the application by Crested Butte Land Trust to put their building, known as the Glacier Homestead, on the local historic register. Jordan provided Brian (CBLT) a list of suggested changes to the application. Justin also provided a list of suggested changes for the application. Both critiques centered around focusing the application on the building and how it represents/contributes to the ranching and railroad history of the area. Justin also asked for information on what repairs are needed that grant funds could be helpful. He also suggested that the next meeting should be advertised in the Gunnison paper as well. Brian said he would make revisions and send it back to Mike for distribution to the rest of the group.

The group then discussed the request by the Gunnison Arts Center for a letter of support regarding their grant application for funding a new roof. Lee Ann made a motion (2<sup>nd</sup> by Lynn) to send the support letter. It was agreed Mike will draft it and send it to Justin for his signature.

Justin updated the group on the efforts to meet with the Gunnison City Council to discuss the fate of the old City Shop building. Justin said he and Dave have had discussion with the County Manager and City Manager and are working toward setting up a date for the meeting. Justin said he also has spoken with someone at the State Historical Fund on the matter.
