BIG CHANGES IN CORRUGATED

AUGUST, 2019

The cardboard market is under going some major changes that is affecting all recyclers. The acceptable levels of non corrugated cardboard per bale has drastically decreased.

This means that our Center will only be able to take corrugated cardboard. We will no longer be able to accept egg cartons, packing paper, brown paper bags, 6 packs, 12 packs, any flat cardboard like cereal boxes, cracker boxes, etc.
