## **WHAT GOES WHERE?**

Sometimes it is hard to know where to deposit each item. So here is some clarification. If you don't see what you are looking for below please do not hesitate to contact us with further questions.

- 1. Cat food cans and any food cans go in with Tin.**
- 2. Brown packing paper goes in with Cardboard.**
- 3. Put large quantities and large pieces of cardboard in the large drop off area at the south end of the Center, NOT in the deposit windows.**
